3 Types of Living Docs

- YANG Models / semantic versioning:
multiple versions before work completes
- Use cases, design team type docs:
written for internal type use
more archival, things we should remember
- "Living documents"
designed for external consumption
mainly "advice" type documents where the best
practices change over time

This is the one we are talking about here.

GROW Champion

- More stable than an ID, less heavyweight than RFC
- Somewhat like a BCP
The 'C' is for **Current**. :-P
- Routing Security (secure BGP policy)
Advice to operators
This changes over time
Currently in many places, blogs, websites, etc.

Experiment

- Write document in GROW
 - WGLC
 - IETF LC
 - IESG review?!
- RFC Editor cuts new document type - "Living Document"
 - Updates are owned by WG
 - WGLC.
 - Maybe AD approval
- Clear statement that this is "Living"
 - Don't implement
 - Periodic review
